



## PRIVACY POLICY

This document explains the online privacy practices and policy of 1400 Mission Acquisition L.P. for our web site at [www.1400MissionSF.com](http://www.1400MissionSF.com) (this Site). We reserve the right to revise this Privacy Policy (this Privacy Policy) at any time. If we make any substantive changes, we may post bulletins on this Site, will update the date noted below, and reserve the right to provide notice of any changes in other ways as well. Your use of this Site constitutes acceptance of these privacy policies.

### **How We Collect Personally Identifiable Information.**

We do not collect personally identifiable information (PII) unless you voluntarily register on [www.1400MissionSF.com](http://www.1400MissionSF.com). PII includes your name, address, email address, telephone number, social security number, your computer's IP address, and other information that may be used to identify you as an unique individual.

### **Cookies, Web Beacons, and Other Internet Technologies.**

There are various technologies that may be used when you visit our web site to make your experience more enjoyable. A cookie is a small removable data file that is stored by your web browser on your computer. We use cookies to, among other things, identify your computer during a particular visit to this Site and analyze visitor behavior. Most web browsers provide you with the ability to accept or decline cookies, as well as to be warned each time a cookie is being sent.

Web beacons are electronic files that are placed on a web site and allow the website to count users who have visited that page or to access certain cookies. There are also other methods used to collect information about visitors to any website. At this time, we only uses cookies and web beacons for the purpose of collecting information about the visitors to our website in an aggregated form. For instance, we may gather certain information such as the number of unique visitors, the frequency with which they visit and pages viewed. We look at the data in summary form, rather than on an individual basis. We gather this information so we can, for example, learn how many people visit this Site, see which pages are the most viewed and identify which web sites are referring visitors to this Site. However, we do not use cookies, web beacons, or any other internet technology to collect PII about you.

At this time our website does not recognize automated browser signals regarding tracking mechanisms, such as “do not track” instructions. You can generally express your privacy preferences regarding the use of most cookies and similar technologies though your web browser. Look under the heading “Tools” (or similar heading) in your particular browser for information about controlling cookies. You can set your browser in most instances to notify you before you receive a cookie, giving you the chance to decide whether to accept it or not. You can also generally set your browser to turn off cookies. Since cookies allow you to take advantage of some of our Web sites’ features, we recommend that you leave them turned on. If you block, turn off or otherwise reject our cookies, some Web pages may not display properly.



### **How We Use The Personally Identifiable Information You Do Provide.**

As explained above, the only PII we collect via this Site is information you share with us when you voluntarily register your information [www.1400MissionSF.com](http://www.1400MissionSF.com). We use this PII in order to respond to your request and to complete any follow up. We may also share this PII with our limited partners who may use it to contact you about goods and services they believe may be of interest to you. We also reserve the right to share any information collected through this Site with legal authorities if it is, in our sole opinion, necessary to investigate, prevent or otherwise take action regarding suspected fraud, situations involving threats or potential harm or if otherwise required by governmental order (such as by a subpoena, court order or other legal means).

We use a third-party vendor, Amazon.com, to provide a secure, reliable and resilient platform for hosting this Site. Like us Amazon.com strives to take all reasonable precautions necessary to safeguard the confidentiality of any confidential information collected via this Site. Amazon.com is contractually obligated to not make any use of any PII it may learn as a result of its hosting services it provides except as necessary to host the Site.

We may also from time to time use other third parties to assist us with services provided via the Site or in connection with the administration of this Site. These third parties will be or are contractually limited in how they may use any PII they learn; specifically they may only use this PII to the extent necessary to provide the contractually requested goods or services.

Nothing in this policy is intended to interfere with the ability of 1400 Mission Acquisition L.P. to transfer all or part of its business or assets (including this Site, and any PII) to an affiliate or independent third party, at any time, for any reason.

### **Do Not Track Requests.**
